Design a project that demonstrates something about the Lord's creation.

Write a quote from the Word that relates to your topic.

Write at least 5 sentences explaining some facts about your project.

Be prepared to share these facts on the night of the science fair.

Phases of Project

Check off each segment of each phase as it is completed. Refer to the calendar attached for due dates for each segment.

Student must bring in this sheet and work completed to show teacher on each due date.

Phase I

	I brainstormed 2 possible topics.
	I came up with two investigative questions for each topic and wrote them down in my science fair journal.
	I consulted with my teacher and parents about project possibilities.
	I chose a suitable topic.
	I discussed topic with my teacher and gained approval.
	I recorded my chosen topic and my questions for that topic in my science journal.

Phase II

	I asked a parent, teacher or minister to help me find a quote from the Word that fits in with my topic.
	I wrote out the quote neatly on my index card, and decorated it.
	I researched my topic by reading about it in 3 resources

	(books, on line, video, magazine).
	I found answers to my questions and wrote them down in my science journal.
	I wrote down the names of my resources to create my bibliography.
	I developed a plan for my display/project.

Phase III

	I used my research and the answers to my questions to write my sentences explaining what I learned about my topic.
	I created a model, display, etc. for my project.
	I practiced my presentation for the night of the science fair using I created and wrote.
